# New Zealand Ovine Sire Reference...

In 1985 a small group of Coopworth breeders became the first in New Zealand to link flocks by artificially inseminating ewes with select reference sires, made practicable by then recent advances in oestrus synchronisation and insemination technology.

Their objective then, as it still is now, ranking the total sire resource of several flocks through common reference standards, identifying the superior performing sires, and installing them in the next reference sire team.

A quantum leap in sheep breeding, the reference system achieves rapid identification and turn-around of superior improver genestock, on a large scale, and at moderate cost.

The 2001 the adoption of SIL (Sheep Improvement Ltd) genetic engine and across flock analysis services represented a second millennium leap, in expansion of the gene-pool to all client flocks sufficiently linked by AI and inter-flock ram use, and more extensive and definitive breeding value estimation.

NZOSR's commitment to improvement of its system, services, and adoption of new technology continues through utilisation of approved Breeding Services, for collection and processing of semen, and technical support in the North Island, and Lincoln University Agriculture Sciences Dept and Flock-Linc for technical support in the South Island.

**The Reference...**

An independent group of practising sheep breeders and farmers, NZOSR is structured to produce gene stock relevant to the times, selecting and referencing sires for maximum quality production through a unique group selection system that ensures maximum acceptability to members.

Reference flocks have a recommended insemination requirement of 50 ewes, ideally 25 each to two of the catalogued sires, and are required to approve inclusion of flock data in the SIL flock summary, and availability of subsequently proven sires.

NZOSR also supports an FE interest ram-circling cell, and tolerance tested sires are catalogued as options for reference participation.

Reference Sire semen is supplied to member flocks at cost plus a royalty to the ram owner, and is also available for sale outside the reference, and for export subject to conditions applying in country of import.

### **The Sires...**

The sires in this catalogue were selected and ranked for preference by members at their Selection Day held in February 2010, the culmination of the group's 24<sup>th</sup> reference ranking 754 sires used from 2004 - 2009

Index values shown are as represented by the SIL across-flock sire summary run 1<sup>st</sup> February 2010. DPP (Dual Purpose Production Index) is a summary of the overall breeding merit across nominated goal traits, reproduction, survival, growth, meat and wool.
